**DIRECTION:**  
**SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING!** Use 1 to 2 ounces of **AR-CHEM AG SPECTRA-RED** for every 10 gallons of mixed foam solution. If more color is desired by operator, more dye may be added to the foam tank. Be sure **AR-CHEM AG SPECTRA-RED** is the last thing added to the foam generating tank. Rinse empty dye container several times and empty rinse water into the foam tank.

**Note:** *AR-CHEM AG SPECTRA-RED will stain, but may be removed with several washings of soap and water.*
