WINDSHIELD DEICER improves visibility, assures safer driving and prevents slips and falls. Harmless to car finishes.

## DIRECTIONS

Brush away loose snow, spray directly onto windshield and allow to penetrate while spraying other windows. Do not start wiper blades until ice has melted. Also, stop fogging of windows and mirrors by wiping with a clean cloth dampened with WINDSHIELD DEICER.

**DANGER**  **POISON**

Flammable. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Vapor harmful.

Can cause nervous system depression. If ingested, may cause visual system damage. Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat and flame. May be fatal or cause blindness if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. Use only in well ventilated areas. Do not expose to temperatures above 120°F. Do not puncture or incinerate can. Avoid contact with eyes. Avoid prolonged or repeated contact with skin. Methanol may cause eye damage including blindness with prolonged or repeated skin contact or inhalation.

### FIRST AID:

**IF IN EYES:** Flush eyes and under eyelids with plenty of cool water for at least 15 minutes. If irritation persists, obtain medical attention.

**IF ON SKIN:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash with soap and water for 15 minutes. If irritation persists, obtain medical attention.

**IF SWALLOWED:** Seek medical attention immediately. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**IF INHALED:** Remove person to fresh air. If breathing has stopped, administer artificial respiration. Obtain medical attention.
