

FIRST AID:

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or a doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment. For information regarding medical emergencies or pesticide incidents, call 1-877-852-0086.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product provides protection against Mosquitoes, Black Flies, Stable Flies, Sand Flies, Gnats, Fleas, and Ticks.

Read and follow all directions and precautions on this product label. Hold container upright about 4 to 6 inches from skin or clothing. Do not use as a face spray. Do not spray in enclosed areas. Avoid breathing a spray product and do not use it near food. Spray and spread evenly with your hand to moisten all exposed skin. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Do not over apply this product. Heavy application and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. If biting insects do not respond to a thin film of repellent, apply a bit more. Do not apply near eyes and mouth, and apply sparingly around ears. When using sprays, do not spray directly into face, spray on hands first and then apply to face. Do not allow children to handle this product, and do not apply to children's hands. When using on children, apply to your own hands and then put it on the child. Instruct older children in the proper use of this product. Apply this product second if used in conjunction with a sunscreen product. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water or bathe. This is particularly important when repellents are used repeatedly in a day or on consecutive days. Do not use under clothing. For Ticks, apply to shirt and pant cuffs or socks.

Never use repellents over cuts, wounds or irritated skin. Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Do not get in eyes. Do not apply to children's hands. Do not use on infants. Repellents should be applied only to exposed skin and/or clothing such as shirt, pants, hat and socks. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove and wash treated clothing before wearing it again. Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. If you suspect a reaction to this product, discontinue use, wash treated skin and call your physician or local poison control center. If you go to a doctor, take this repellent product with you.

NOTE: Will not damage cotton, wool, or nylon. Do not apply on or near acetate, rayon, Spandex or synthetic fabrics (other than nylon), furniture, plastics (such as eyeglasses and watch crystals), leather and painted or varnished surfaces (including automobiles).
